ABOUT THE CAST

JOAN SMITH (Mollie Ralston)—audiences will remember Joan as the wacky chorine in the 1961 NFCT production of "Born Yesterday". More recently she played a leading role in last year's production of "Petticoat Fever". Besides being the producer of last year's hit musical comedy, "Damn Yankees" and directing the workshop production of "Sorry, Wrong Number", Joan has also been a member of the Board of Directors of the NFCT for the past two years.

CHARLES SMITH (Giles Ralston)—an accomplished organist. This energetic young man managed to find the time to design the set for "Damn Yankees". He played the romantic lead opposite his wife, Joan, in "Born Yesterday" and had bit roles in both "Damn Yankees" and "The Hasty Heart".

JEFF SMITH (Christopher Wren)—no relation to Charles and Joan Smith, appeared in the Smithtown High School production of Dickens' "Christmas Carol". Now residing in Mattituck he sang as a soloist at the high school minstrel show. His last appearance was as one of the song and dance boys in that wild "Steam Heat" number in this season's NFCT production of "Pajama Game".

MARY STURM (Mrs. Boyle)—this versatile performer is well known to Riverhead audiences. With the Riverhead Dramatic Guild she appeared in "Picnic", "My Three Angels", "Ladies in Retirement" and "Bell, Book and Candle". In the summer stock production at the Gateway Theatre in Bellport she played the role of Lillian in "Middle of the Night". She last appeared as one of the factory girls in "Pajama Game".

RUSSELL MANN (Major Metcalf)—a stock broker by profession, Russ was so impressive as Max the Salesman in "Pajama Game" that he was the unanimous choice of the casting committee for his present role.

CLACIA YOUNG (Mrs. Carswell)—moving downstage from a stint as "prop" girl for "Pajama Game", Clacia is making her first appearance with the NFCT. With her husband, Hal (Critic's Choice), she was active with Chester (Vt.) Players. For four years running their group was first prize winners in a series of one-act plays in Woodstock, Vermont sponsored by the Nellie Gill Competitions of that city.

Y.) and in off-Broadway productions of "Angel Street", "Caine Mutiny Court Martial", "Barrabas", "Pygmalion" and "Private Lives". On TV he has appeared in "Car 54" and "The Defenders". For the NFCT he played one of the factory mechanics in "Pajama Game". Now residing in Southold, Broadway's loss is our gain.
