ABOUT THE CAST

MIKE DOUGHERTY (Dr. Frederick Baston)—is a newcomer to the North Fork Community I heatre stage but not to acting. While attending Adelphi Suttolk College ne appeared in Ionesco's "Bald Soprano" and Pirandello's "Henry IV". He teaches at Westhampton Beach High School and resides in Southold.

HUNOR REYNOLDS (Anne Callifer)—is fast becoming a veteran actress for the NFCT. She played the difficult role of the hallucination ridden child in last season's production of "The Cruciple". She

is a student at Mattituck High School.

GERTRUDE REYNOLDS (Sara Callifer)—a long time summer resident of the North Fork and now residing year round in Mattituck. Gertrude was previously active with the Nutley (N. J.) Little Theater where she was seen in "Cuckoos on the Hearth", "Berkeley Square" and "Letters to Lucerne". Not to be outdone by her daughter, Honor, she joined the NFCT and immediately won critical acclaim as Ruth, the unhappy wife, in last season's "Blithe Spirit".

PEGGY FELLOWES (Mrs. Callifer)—any appearance by Peggy in an NFCT production is eagerly anticipated by theatre goers of the North Fork. One of the founders of the NFCT, Peggy played the role of Mrs. Dexter in "The Man Who Came To Dinner" and Reba in "Visit to a Small Planet". As the murder victim in "Night Must Fall", the comical neighbor of the fabulous Joe Hardy in "Damn Yankees" and as the proud mother in "Separate Tables", Peggy has proved

her acting versatility to NFCT audiences.
DAVID DETRICH (John Callifer)—specializes in doing two jobs in each production of the NFCT. He was assistant director and performed the difficult role of Thomas Putnam in the last season's production of Arthur Millers' exciting drama, "The Crucible". He next acted in "Kiss Me Kate" while at the same time performing efficiently backstage as stage manager. In this production he again performs a double function as actor and producer. Dave teaches at Southold High School and lives in East Marion.

HALLOCK YOUNG (James Callifer)—began his acting career in the role of "Henry Aldrich" in a high school production of "What A Life". After serving in the U. S. Navy, he moved to Vermont where he was active with the Chester (Vt.) Players playing major roles in many of their productions. Now a building contractor in his native Riverhead, Hal has been active with the NFCT both in set design and ("The Mouse Trap") and in playing leading roles in NFCT production of "Critics Choice" and "The Crucible". In last season's musical hit "Kiss Me Kate" he was acclaimed by both critics and audiences for his singing of the Petruccio role.

LOU PADAVAN (Coroner)—teaches at Westhampton Beach High School and has had roles in last season's "The Crucible" and acted and danced in the hit musical "Kiss Me Kate", besides serving as stage hand, and with his wife as party caterer extraordinaire.

He has had major roles in "Romanoff and Juliet", "Night Must Fall", "Glass Menagerie", "The Hasty Heart", "Petticoat Fever", "Critics Choice", "The Mousetrap", "Separate Tables", "The Crucible" and "Blithe Spirit". He has been the director of all NFCT musical productions. An accomplished singer and pianist Jack spent his summer vacation writing the book and music for a complete musical story for children entitled "Peanut Butter Prince", soon to be produced by the NFCT.

JOAN DE HAYES (Mrs. Potter)—comes to us from Rocky Point where she resides via Riverhead where she is employed as a secretary by the Suffolk County Department of Mental Health. Her previous acting experience consists of a role in "The Judge" a fantasy performed at Washington Irving High School in N. Y. City. For a year and a half she worked backstage at The Village Playhouse in Greenwich Village, N. Y. C. doing props, scenery, costumes, make-up, etc.


