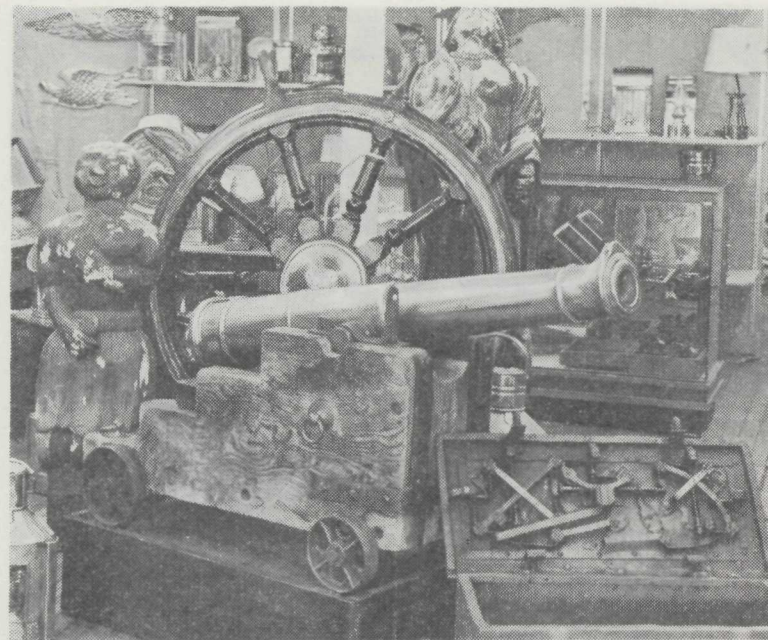

"The gay, intimate musical "She Loves Me" blew on to Broadway like a breath of fresh air and captured the hearts of the audiences and critics alike. An elegant European parfumerie in the 1930's brings together a soft-spoken clerk, Georg Nowak, and a hopelessly romantic sales girl, Amalia Balash, whose relationship seems destined to be a marathon quarrel for which the only relief is their lonely hearts correspondence, each with an anonymous "Dear Friend". Under the combined talents of Masteroff, Bock and Harnick, the course of their affairs is woven into a bright, spirited story that, in the words of Norman Nadel of The World Telegram and Sun, "is a musical with which everyone can fall in love" and, according to John Chapman of the Daily News, is "so charming, so deft, so light and so right that it makes all the music-shows in the big Broadway shops look like clodhoppers".

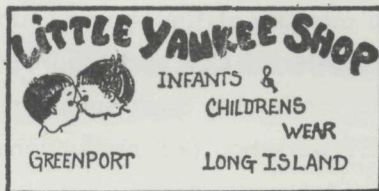

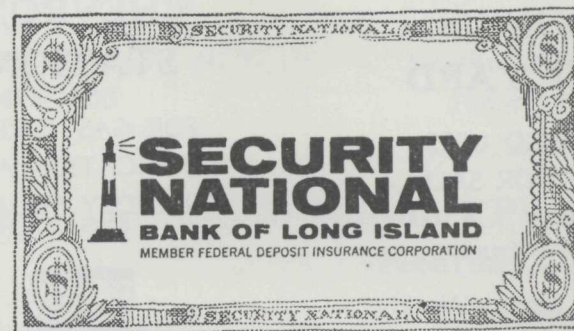
