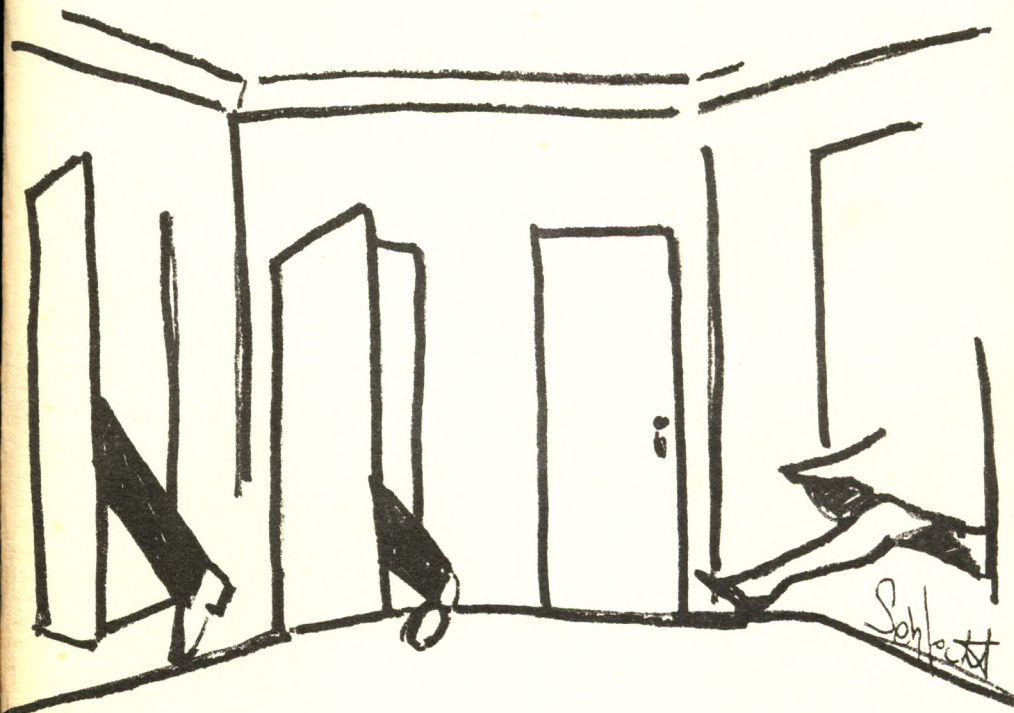

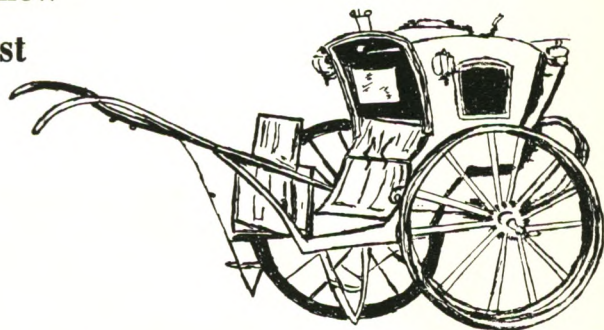

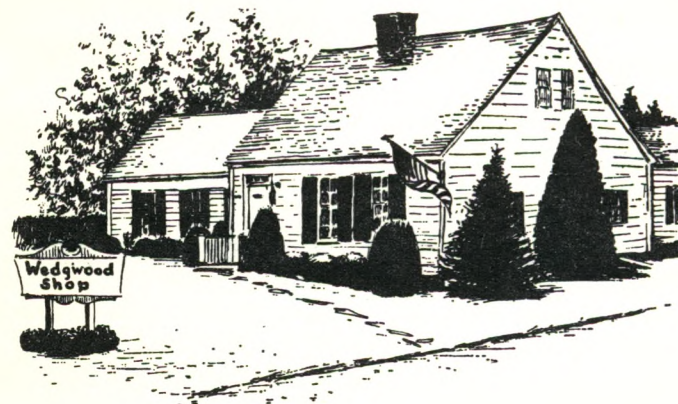
A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT
