Who's Who

GEORGIA O'CONNOR (*Alma Winemiller*) is making her debut as a dramatic actress following appearances in musical productions of *Finian's Rainbow*, *Man of La Mancha* and *Bells Are Ringing*.

JACK REED (*John Buchanan, Jr.*) is a charter member of the NFCT, and has been seen in *The Man Who Came to Dinner*, *The Little Foxes*, *Little Moon of Alban*, *Haunting of Hill House* & others.

TEENA CHRISTIE (*Mrs. Winemiller*) started her stage career in Pelham, N. Y. and has appeared with the NFCT in *Auntie Mame* and *Carnival*. She has also worked with *Youth on Stage* and *Summer Players*.

JON RICHMOND (*Rev. Winemiller*) has appeared in *Bell, Book and Candle*, *The Little Foxes*, *Little Moon of Alban*, has directed *Bells Are Ringing* and *Carnival*, and done just about anything theatrical.

MAURA CLARKE (*Nellie Ewell*) is making her stage debut, having worked backstage on last season's production of *Spoon River Anthology*. She operates the Peconic Bay Art School & Schoolhouse Creek Interiors.

JOHN CHRISTIE (*Dr. Buchanan, Sr.*) appeared in Pelham, N. Y. in *Guys and Dolls*, *Bells Are Ringing* and *You Can't Take It With You*. He made his debut with NFCT in *Auntie Mame*.

MARJORIE TUTHILL (*Rosa Gonzales*) is a newcomer to the NFCT, although she has lived in Riverhead for 9 years. This is her first venture into dramatics since her high school days.

DAVID TOMEI (*Roger Doremus*) came to try-outs as a spectator and now finds himself making his stage debut. He has been a UPI photographer, a filmmaker, and is a newcomer to the area.

PATRICIA FORREST (*Mrs. Bassett*) comes out of self-imposed retirement from theatrics because "I owe it to the world". She is attractive, intelligent, wears a size 9 shoe, and appeared in *The Rose Tattoo*.

ART QUINTANA (*Gonzales*) is making his third appearance with the NFCT. Last season he delighted audiences with his performance in *Carnival*. He first appeared on the NFCT stage in *Man of La Mancha*.

SUSAN WIEGAND (*Rosemary*) is a 13-year-old who is already a seasoned performer. Her portrayal of Gloria in the NFCT production of *Wait Until Dark* displayed a natural talent for acting.

JOHN RASANEN (*Archie Kramer*) will be best remembered for his performance as Sancho in *Man of La Mancha*. He has appeared in *The Boy Friend* in Mineola and with the *3rd Army Chorus Productions*.

LAUREN LESSARD (*Young Alma*), a 12-year-old from Mattituck, is making her first appearance with the NFCT. She has acted the role of a prime minister in a school production of a Chinese play.

ADAM DERRICK (*Young Johnny*) appeared with *Youth on Stage* this past summer. He is an honor student at Riverhead Junior High who caught the theatre bug at an early age living in N.Y.C.

ALLEN DERRICK (*Director*) is a former professional actor and has played with many of the great names in theatre. Last year he directed *See How They Run* and was George in *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf*.

JUDY UTTER (*Producer*) is a multi-talented lady who can handle just about any job in the theatre. She can also act and has appeared in recent productions of *Auntie Mame* and *The Price*.
