





stage crew . . . All (including actors) should be listed under props. To avoid repetition I have given my staff credit only under the committee they volunteered for.

In a production of this type it is difficult to divide jobs into neat pigeor-holes, so against usual procedures, when I spoke to each person I didn't give them any guide to their responsibilities. I asked only for cooperation between themselves and with me — and I got it!



"There is a vast, untapped area of experimental theater (writing, acting, direction, set design and lighting) which gave rise to N. Y.'s Off Broadway — much of which has been enormously successful. NFCT should consider giving it a try. In the area of set design, it is possible to create the mood and atmosphere of a play effectively and inexpensively with other than conventional methods. That is the challenge."






