BIOGRAPHIES

ALLEN DERRICK (Director and Prof. Carpenter) came to the NFCT with a substantial theatrical background and has expanded it by three times a director and two times a professor. The other shows directed were "See How They Run" and "Summer and Smoke." The other professor was George in "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf." Allen is a real estate agent and lives with his son and assorted pets in Jamesport.

GEORGE STAHLER (Ali Ben Salaam) proves that a Suffolk County Probation Officer can be a very funny man. He was on stage in college and elsewhere. This is his second appearance with the NFCT. His first was in "Cabaret." George lives with his wife and son in Southold, but all three are usually found at the theatre when there is work to be done here.

PAT REED (Virginia Carpenter) is in her thirteenth year and seventeenth show with the NFCT. Her contributions include costumes, make-up, lights, singing, dancing, acting, producing and directing. In addition to various roles in "The Happy Time," "Peanut Butter Prince," "Kiss Me Kate," "Damn Yankees" and "Jack in a Box," Pat was feminine lead in "There Comes a Time," "Critics Choice" and "Little Moon of Alban." Lately, she directed "40 Carats." When she is not in the theatre, Pat is a RN and lives with her lovely swimming pool, husband and children in Baiting Hollow.

JEWELL GONZALEZ (Mrs. Garrison) lives with her husband and two children in Southold and teaches remedial reading in Greenport Elementary School. From costumes for "Summer and Smoke" to a Bluebird Girl in "Carnival" and a Kit Kat Girl in "Cabaret" to this – Jewell is definitely going places.

LINDA SZYMANOWSKI (Wanda Lutz) lives in Cutchogue. She started acting in school and has continued with Youth on Stage and the NFCT. With growing despair, she has been cast as hookers, con artists, eccentric old women and dumb bunnies, but so was Bette Davis. Most recently Linda was Stage Manager for "A Thousand Clowns" and played a kit kat girl in "Cabaret".

BILL CLAUDIO, Jr. (George Winston-Turnbull III) We have a pro in our midst. Bill was in several productions in the service and elsewhere with lead roles in "The Gazebo" and "A Thousand Clowns". He appeared in the Woody Allen movie "Sleeper", 2 one hour TV specials and has done radio and TV commercials. This is his first NFCT appearance. He lives in Greenport with Nancy plus five.

BERNADETTE ALDCROFT (Prof. Patricia MacDonald) is a native of Riverhead and a graduate of The College of St. Rose where she appeared in productions of "The King and I", "The Women" and "Blithe Spirit". This is her second NFCT appearance. The first was in "40 Carats". She lives and teaches music in Southold.

BILLIE BURGESS (Mrs. Lutz) was Betty in "No No Nanette" but this is her first NFCT role. She lives in New Suffolk with her husband and daughter and a cat named Mergatroyd. Huh?

RONNIE O'REGAN (Mrs. Carpenter) is also a newcomer to the NFCT. She is a college girl and former WAVE who modestly admits to having had some theatrical experience on her way to the NFCT. She lives in Jamesport with her husband and four children.

JUDY UTTER (Producer) is the driving force of the NFCT—our President. She has appeared in "The Price", "Auntie Mame" and most recently in "40 Carats". She lives in a house and theatre in Mattituck. We bless Judy for all she is doing on stage, back stage and all around these towns.
