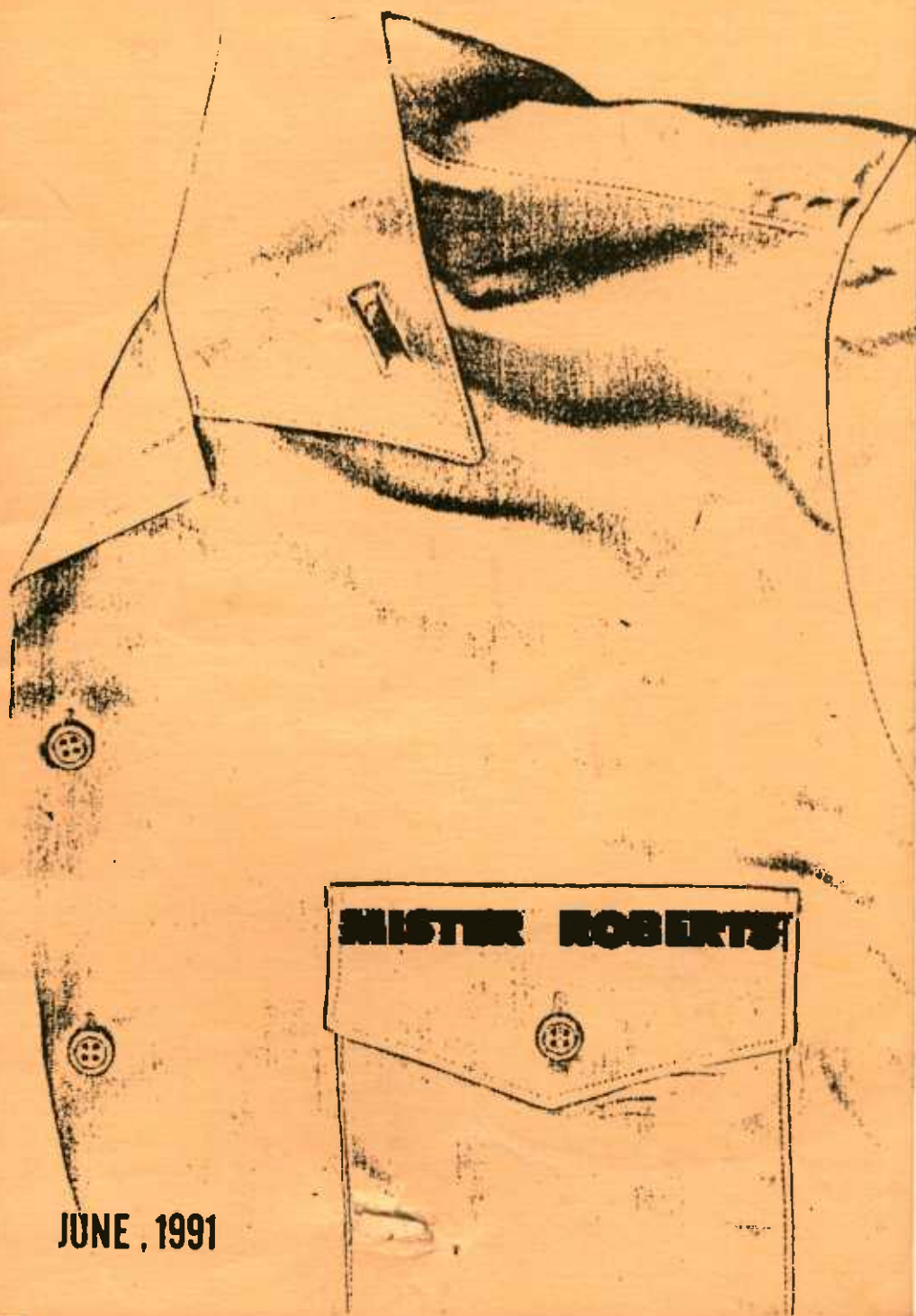

BIOGRAPHIES

Glenn Abramowitz (*Payne*) – Returning to the stage after 15 years, Glenn is making his debut at NFCT. No stranger to playing multiple roles, Glenn had three roles in the S.U.C. New Paltz production of *Our Town* and eight in Miller Place High School's first major production – *George M!*

John B. Belmonte (*Dolan*) – John holds a B.A. in drama from Hofstra University. He recently appeared as Paul in the Long Island premier of *The Lisbon Traviata*. John hopes to eventually make acting his full-time profession.

Harry Farrell (*Doc*) – Harry is a retired school administrator who resides in Greenport with his wife, Charmian. Last year he made his debut in *The Crucible* as Francis Nurse.

He has appeared in *South Pacific* opposite Brian Green and Wade Karlin's 'mazin' coconuts. He works at Silver Sands Motel, but expects to return to school and get a brainwashing . . . er . . . um . . . teaching degree, in the near future. Congratulations Tom and Christine.

Wade Karlin (*Ensign Pulver*) – At last a part Wade can relate to: a hapless, lazy, disorganized . . . & lecherous Ensign (only kidding). Wade's been kicking around the NFCT for a few years and he just loves it. He's been in a number of shows, including *South Pacific*, *Don't Drink the Water*, and *Bus Stop*. Melissa Anne Moelius (*Lt. Ann Girard*) – Melissa seems to remember being on this stage before (*Deja vous*, perhaps?) She refuses to bore the audience with a list of her credits, but will say her last appearance was in *Sweet Charity*. She also wishes to thank all the men in this cast for making her feel like "one of the guys." (Well, almost!)

Jason Pinson (*Lindstrom*) – Jason was last seen in the Mattituck High School production of *Winners*. Being the smallest of the happy sailors, the theory is that he ran away at 16 and lied about his age.

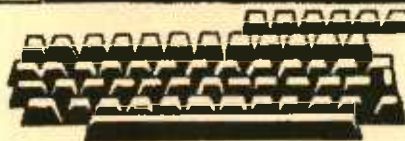

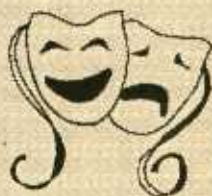
