

Karen Becker (Manicurist)—Karen has helped out behind the scenes for other NFCT productions, but this is her first official time on stage. However, she does put on 180 performances a year as a Social Studies teacher at Riverhead High School. Karen resides in Southold with her husband Brian.

Michael Cybulski (Assistant Manager)—Mike has been in many NFCT productions. His last appearance was in A Chorus Line as Greg. Mike is going on to his last semester at Suffolk County Community College and he hopes to transfer to a college somewhere overseas (preferably where it's warm). Frank Gianakos (Harry Brock)—Frank makes his return to the theatre after a three-year-absence. He last performed at NFCT in Where's Charley. Among his credits are Lend Me a Tenor (Saunders) and Twelve Angry Jurors (Foreman).
