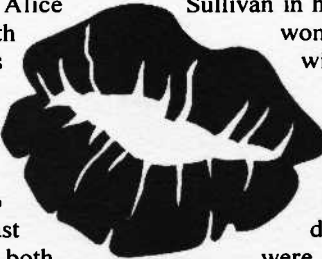
# No Way To Treat A Lady

## KILLER STRIKES AGAIN

NEW YORK, June 19 — Police today are desperately sifting through an overabundance of clues in an effort to solve the murder of a woman found strangled last night in her apartment at 30 Riverside Drive. The body was discovered by Detective Morris Brummell of the 34th Precinct who *received a call from the killer* at shortly after nine o'clock last evening. The killer directed Brummel to the murder. Efforts to trace the call proved fruitless.

There is no doubt that the killer is the same man who, a month ago, strangled Mrs. Alice Sullivan in her apartment at 217 East 79th Street. Both women were found in identical positions with the imprint of a kiss drawn in lipstick across their foreheads. Indeed, there are so many connections between the two women that police are somewhat at a loss on where to begin. Both women were killed on the last day of the month, both were widowed, both were close to the same
