NEW YORK, June 19 — Police today are desperately sifting through an overabundance of clues in an effort to solve the murder of a woman found strangled last night in her apartment at 30 Riverside Drive. The body was discovered by Detective Morris Brummell of the 34th Precinct who received a call from the killer at shortly after nine o'clock last evening. The killer directed Brummel to the murder. 
