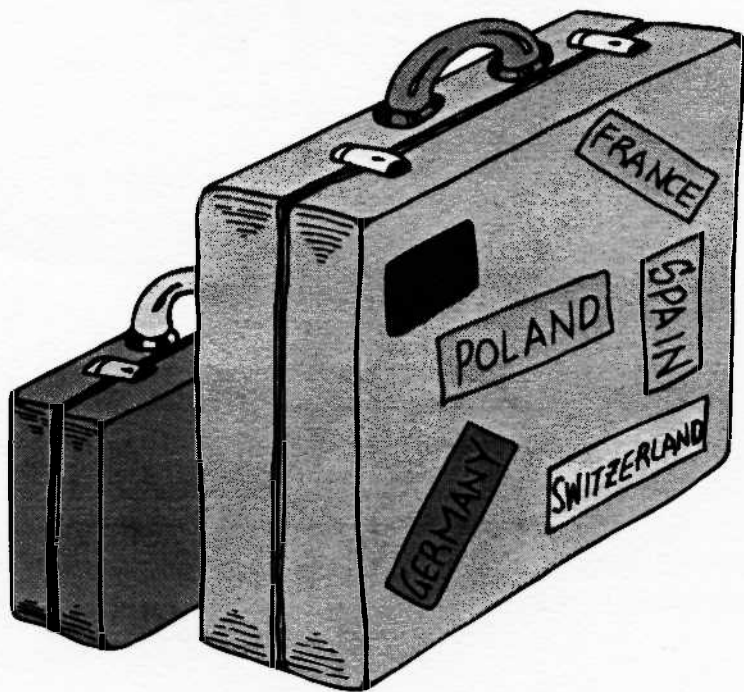

Who's Who

Janet Bidwell (*Betty Meeks*)—Janet has appeared in many shows at the NFCT including *Carousel*, *Oliver*, *Hello Dolly*, and *Rumors*. She is currently on the Board of Directors.

Brett Chizever (*Ellard Simms*)—Brett is very excited to be back on the North Fork Community Theatre stage again. You may remember him in his past NFCT performances when he was Seymour Krelbourn in *Little Shop of Horrors* or when he played Charlie Dalrymple in *Brigadoon*. He dedicates this show to not only his lovely girlfriend Erin and his amazing family but to the Scheers whom he likes to think of as a second family. He'd like to thank Mrs. Scheer for this wonderful opportunity and Chris for just being Chris.

Dick Holbrook (*Owen Musser*) Dick, currently a student at SCCC, is happy to return for his third show at the NFCT. His two previous shows were *Cinderella* (Herald) and *Little Shop of Horrors* (Wino I, Skip Snipley, et al). Prior to NFCT, Dick was active with Riverhead High School's Blue Masques in such shows as *On The Town* (Pitkin W. Bridgework), *The Man Who Came To Dinner* (Mr. Stanley) and *Anything Goes!* (Ching). He also was in the chorus for RFCT's *Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*. This one's for all his extended family. You know who you are.

Michael Horn (S/Sgt. "Froggy" LeSueur)—This marks Michael's official return to the stage for an NFCT production after an absence of a few years. He was seen here in an original musical *Mirth*, in the role of Gorin, which he originated. He has been in several productions at the Airport Play House, including *Guy in the Ritz*, Frank & John in *Lovers and the Other Strangers*. He was also in the Epic Theater production of *The Outsiders* and the original production *2AM* as Gus. At the Riverhead Faculty Community Theater, he was in *Joseph & the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, *Oliver*, and as Merlin in *Camelot*. He directed several productions for RFCT including *The Pajama Game* and *L'il Abner*. Other performances were in *A Few Good Men*, *Mr. Roberts*, *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*, *Working*, *Annie Get Your Gun*, *South Pacific* and *Morning's at Seven*. However, his favorite role

to date has been Scotty in *Tribute*. He thanks Diana and the rest of his family and friends for all their love and support.

Wade Karlin (*Rev. David Marshall Lee*)—After being gone for awhile, he's back at the NFCT. Wade cut his teeth here, with such productions as *Bus Stop*, *Picnic*, and *South Pacific*. He has had the good fortune to work with this fine cast & crew. He hopes you enjoy the show!

Kristen Santori (*Catherine Simms*)—*The Foreigner* marks Kristen's fifth NFCT production. However it is the first, regular season show that she has been in. Her other NFCT performances include *Annie* (2000), *Brigadoon* (2002), and *Little Shop of Horrors* (2003). She was last seen at the NFCT as the Queen in the summer production of *Cinderella*. Besides NFCT productions, Kristen has been involved in school plays. Her last performance was the role of Hattie in Westhampton Beach's *Kiss me Kate*. Kristen is currently a senior at Westhampton Beach High School and is planning to pursue acting when she gets to college. She dedicates her performance in *The Foreigner* to her dearest friend Reina Nash, who will always be her social twin and acting/singing buddy. RIP Reina. She thanks you all for coming and hopes you enjoy the show.

Clayton Sauer (*Charlie Baker*)—Clayton most recently appeared at NFCT as Sebastien in *Nude with Violin*. He has appeared Off-Broadway in *Toulouse and Dionysiac*, at Buck's County Playhouse in *Pirates of Penzance* and in the European tour of *Hair*. His favorite regional and stock roles include Abner in *Li'l Abner*, Pierre in *The Merry Widow*, and Lamar in *Godspell*. Film work includes "Go For It", "BeatStreet", and "The Muppets Take Manhattan". He has appeared in the NBC film "Too Far To Go", "The Guiding Light", and several forgettable commercials. A member of AFTRA, Clay currently owns The Stirling House Bed and Breakfast in Greenport, and is a realtor with Prudential Elliman in Southold. He would like to thank his friends and family for their support, and wishes to dedicate this performance to his favorite foreigner, his late French mother, Jacqueline, whose humor and good spirits continue to inspire her family's lives.
