

Kevin Monsell (Obadiah & George)—Mr. Monsell has been haunting the NFCT stage for several years. He attributes his durability to the surprising volume of voice, his inability to recognize embarrassment, and, more seriously, the support of friends and family—most of all his wife Cathy.


