





A proud member of Actors' Equity, Michael has performed in and/or directed classical, contemporary and musical theater productions in 46 of the 48 continental United States. Locally, he directed and co-authored This Just In and As You Were, two full-length historical musical revues for the Oysterponds Historical Society, and played the Charles Boyer role in Gaslight for The Shelter Island Players. As a composer-lyricist, Michael's latest project is a new musical set on the North Fork in the 1930's and inspired by Ivan Turgenev's comedy, A Month in the Country. His longest-running role, and perhaps his most persuasive, is as an intellectual property attorney specializing in the music and entertainment industries, most recently for The RCA Records Label and Sony BMG Music Entertainment.


