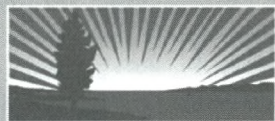

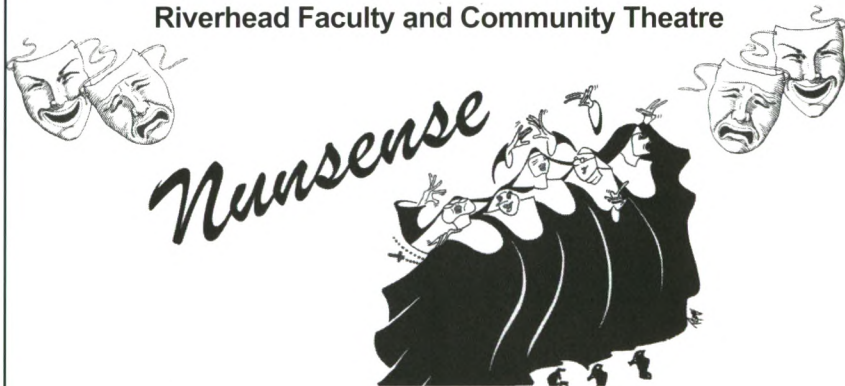

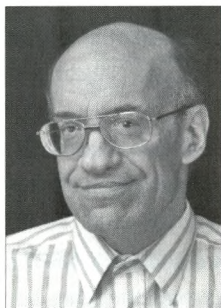
NFCT Art Show Preview: Pat Feiler
