



Director's Note -

My first concern was whether *One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest* would hold up. Even though it started as a book by Ken Kesey and became a play, it is the movie with Jack Nicholson's iconic portrayal of McMurphy that most people remember. (Well, most people of the boomer generation.) Would a piece that spoke to the rebelliousness of the Hippie generation resonate with today's society? The book and play, after all, used the metaphor of a psychiatric hospital to highlight the "power and control" issues of the 60's and 70's.

Then it dawned on me that concerns about "power and control" have not gone away. It was at that point that each scene's power struggles became clear and meaningful. There is, of course, the central conflict between Nurse Ratched and Randall P. McMurphy. But there are other struggles between Harding and McMurphy, Nurse Ratched and Billy, and Nurse Ratched and Dr. Spivey.

There is a lot of humor in this play that at times emanates from the behavior of the mentally ill patients. Back then, that was fair game. But, our society has learned a lot about mental illness since the 60's. Nevertheless, playwright Dale Wasserman sees the patients with love and sympathy.

There is tragedy in this play which seems to come from society's inability to deal with mental illness with sensitivity and understanding. It's sad that we still don't seem to view mental illness with the same intensity and concern that we do other serious (viral and bacteriological) illnesses.




