## CAST BIOS



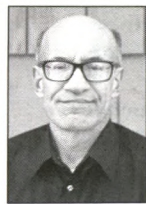

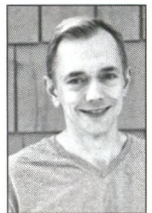

\$300,000 in donations were matched!

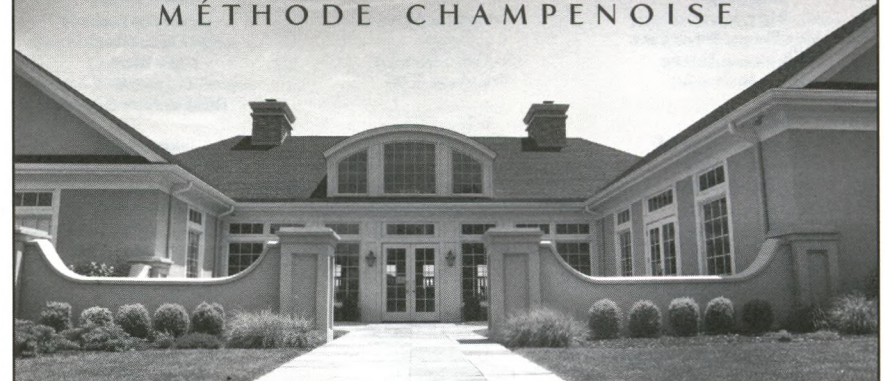

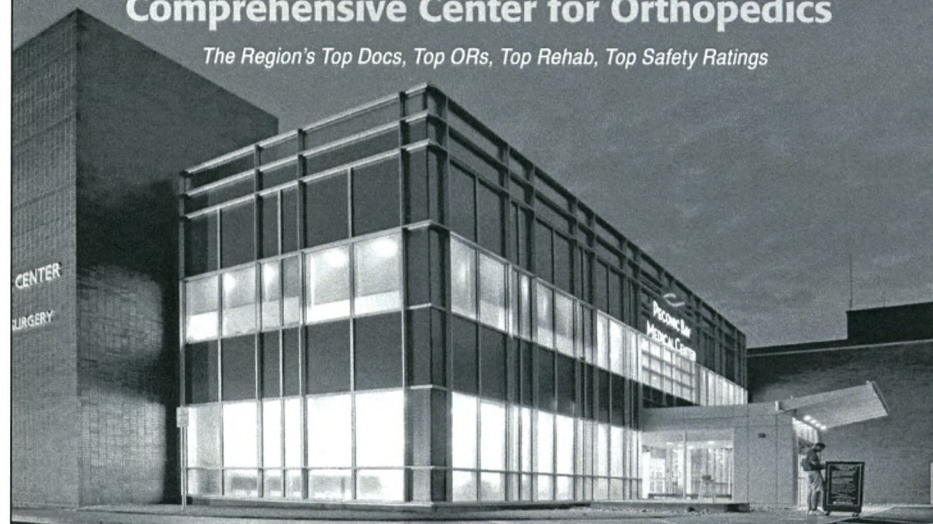
