Director's Note:

Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf? was Edward Albee's first full length play to be brought to the stage and it won a Tony Award for best play. He had gained attention with his previous one act plays, *The Zoo Story* and *The American Dream*. The production on Broadway in 1962 caused a sensation with its coarse language and unblinking look at a toxic marriage in an Ivory Tower setting of education and high ideals. Based on real friends of Albee's who were infamous for their raucous weekend drinking bouts, the play presents a dark contrast to the popular culture depictions of marriage and family life presented in 1950's movies and television programs such as *Father Knows Best*. With its sly reference to the First Family of the United States, George and Martha Washington, this raw depiction of highly educated, sophisticated people self-medicating their pain and disappointments while creating their own co-dependent universe, still resonates with modern audiences.
