We are very excited to be performing here at Harbes WineBarn! Thank you to the Harbes Family for allowing the NFCT to perform here. It is a beautiful venue and perfect for the fall/spooky performances we have in store for you today! I am also excited about performing here because the reason we are performing at an 'off-site' venue is because we are renovating the North Fork Community Theatre. Our theater's "Home Sweet Home" is a converted 1800's church at 12700 Old Sound Avenue in Mattituck that we have performed in since 1962. We started the renovations in August, and hope to be able to open back up this spring. The improvements will include adding an orchestra pit, a rehearsal room, a storage room, and theatrical technology including new lighting and rigging infrastructure. So far, we have raised over \$820,000 out of the \$950,000 needed for the project.
