Director's Note:

Much like the character of Jo March, I have a fire within me. A fire that compels me to create. A fire that always brings me back to molding a work for the stage. It is a sanctuary for me. Rehearsals become a three-hour block of my life where my only worry is what is created on that stage. Ideally, the end product will inspire my audience as well as my cast and will help all involved and all watching to contemplate their own circumstances and appreciate their own life. Each show I direct has a special quality, unique enough that I am interested in tackling the project. In *Little Women*, of course, it is the women. It is a rare show that offers six female lead and supporting characters for women of all ages, all with interesting and emotional character arcs as well as opportunities for all to show off their acting and vocal ability. More than anything, these women are role models. None more than Jo March, a character I idolized when I read the book in middle school and rediscovered upon watching the movie in high school. More than any other character in any other show, I have identified with Jo March. Her quick temper, her passion, her desperation to hold things together, her longing to break from convention, her desire to be "better", are all qualities I see in myself (for better or for worse). It has been a beautiful experience watching Brianna take this character I've loved for so long and bring her to life, beyond my very high expectations. I hope you fall in love with her performance, and all the performances, just as I do every night. And I hope spending the next couple of hours with these characters will move you, make you think, but most importantly make you feel. 150 Years after Louisa May Alcott first published her novel, the themes are still relevant, still poignant. Yes, this show is about finding your own way and refusing to accept the boundaries society lays out for you. But above all else, it is about love, in many forms. I hope you feel the astonishing amount of love we have all put into this project. Please enjoy!


