



Director's Note:

Just a little perspective (which is quite appropriate for a play about Picasso and Einstein), the play takes place in Paris in 1904. A year later, Einstein introduced his groundbreaking work, The Theory of Relativity. It totally changed how the scientific community viewed the world. Three years later, Picasso painted his equally groundbreaking painting, "Les Demoiselles D'Avignon." It totally changed how the artistic world viewed the world. Steve Martin has fictionally brought together these two giants of the twentieth century for a hilariously—yet insightful—look at how art and science are quite different while being similar at the same time.

Steve Martin is a lot more than the "wild and crazy guy" we all know. He's written plays, novels, movies and short stories. He is a knowledgeable art collector and musician. He really is a renaissance guy. I have been wanting to explore this play for many years and am now glad that I have gotten to do it.

What has made it even more satisfying is that I worked with a particularly talented group of actors drawn from all over the island. And, as the character Sagot says in the play, actors needed a creatively well-thought-out frame to work in. I again got to work with an inspired costumer and a meticulously focused set designer to depth to the themes of the play.

The good news is so do you!


