Director's Note

We have been waiting for this moment for years! "The Producers" has been "in production" since 2018. We planned to produce it in the Spring of 2019, but were unable to get the performance rights. So we opened our doors after our 2018-2019 building technology/infrastructure renovation to the fun and quirky ode to musical theatre "The Drowsy Chaperone," (which I had a blast directing.) So here we are now, in the Spring of 2022, and we are overjoyed to be doing this hilarious, complex, and beautiful show. Mel Brooks's dialog and scenes sparkle with humor. Our cast has launched into the off the wall characters with gusto. Rehearsals are opportunities to laugh and be surprised about how much fun there is to find in a small wink, or a huge gag.

"The Producers" is a huge show - with a cast of 25, approximately 150 costumes, 12 dance numbers and a dozen different scene locations. We would not have been able to put on this show without the support of Michael and Emilie Corey, the Associate Producers for the show. I am also very lucky to have a devoted production team - all volunteers of course - who have spent hundreds of hours each working on the show: set, costumes, lights, choreography, music, and production. Every day we all pop in and out of the building, working on different parts of the show, not for money, or because we have to, but simply because we want to. We enjoy making the show come alive - because it makes us happy

The Producers is the first full length musical at the NFCT to use our new video wall, which allows us to play any image or video at the back of our stage. We also are making full use of the upgrades to our rigging that were done during the renovation, which allow us to raise, lower and slide in set pieces. These technology upgrades have transformed our production capabilities, and we have you, our patrons and supporters to thank.
