
THE NEWLY RENOVATED NORTH FORK COMMUNITY THEATRE

In addition to the professionals completing the construction and theatrical technology installations, NFCT volunteers have been tirelessly working on improving the theatre including organizing our props (Doreen Kirby), costumes (Linda Gordon) and Dressing Room Revamp (Mike Hipp). I am so excited about how we have worked together to make these renovations come true!

The renovations included a new orchestra pit, rehearsal room, lighting infrastructure, rigging infrastructure, acoustic treatments and so much more. These infrastructure renovations included significant HVAC, electrical work and set the stage for future renovations to the auditorium, seats, and bathroom. 




