Many of us have been touched one way or another by the devastating effects of Dementia on a parent or loved one. Witnessing this insidious disease is nothing less than heartbreaking. Playwright Florian Zeller has given us perhaps the most realistic portrayal of dementia ever put on stage. You may at times over the course of the show, feel frustrated. You may find yourself feeling a little confused. You may even find yourself laughing at inappropriate times. Please know this is deliberate. You are about to experience a story through the eyes of someone with dementia- through the eyes of The Father. Thank you for supporting NFCT and live theatre. Without you, we could not bring challenging and artistic plays like this one to the North Fork.

## The Director's Bio...

Mark Heidemann (Director) In 1998 Mark was cast in the role of Eugene in Neil Simon's *Broadway Bound* at NFCT. He never thought it would take 26 years to return but he's delighted to be back. For the past two years Mark has been directing for Bonnie Grice's boots on the ground theater. Recent shows include *The Agitators*, *Chemical Imbalance: A Jekyll and Hyde Play* and most recently, *The Chalk Garden*. Mark is Sales Director for Historic Films Archive in Greenport and serves on the board of Corchaug Repertory Theatre.

She currently serves on the board of Corchaug Repertory Theatre and the advisory board of the North Fork Arts Center. **Rusty Kransky** (*André*) was born in Tasmania and reared in California. From the Artist's Corner

### Cynthia Wells

Artist Cynthia Wells has created drawings derived from *The Father*.

Wells has captured unscripted behind-the-scenes character studies of actors portraying a man's descent into dementia. She was awarded the Huntington Arts Council grant for the project. "My drawing technique is animation drawing, so I use design, detail, and exaggeration to capture the essence of a theatrical moment." Wells believes that her drawings will give audiences a different perspective on the play.

Cynthia Wells is an internationally exhibited artist, animation filmmaker, and a commercial animation director. She studied at California Institute of the Arts from 1976-79 before being hired by Walt Disney Studios. As a filmmaker Wells produced and directed her own film, "Interview with Talullah, Queen of the Universe", which won her nominations for two Annie Awards for outstanding achievement in animation and achievement in a short film. Her second film, "The Shadow of Doubt" won six awards and played in 26 film festivals. Wells worked as supervising animator on "Once Upon A Forest" (20th Century Fox), and "The Thief and the Cobbler" (Miramax), and as an animator on "The Fox and the Hound" (Disney), and "Condor Man" (Disney). Her profile on IMDB.com credits her with over ninety films and commercials.

Her paintings have been exhibited in New York, San Francisco, Ottawa, Los Angeles, West Hollywood and Santa Monica, CA.
