



CAST BIOS

Esmeralda Cabrera (Butcher/Wounded Woman/Cicero Grocer) - Esme is enjoying acting in her fourth show with NFCT. Last year she appeared in *The Laramie Project, The Producers* and *One Christmas Eve at Evergreen Mall.* She also appeared in the boots on the ground production of *A Chemical Imbalance* and Northeast Stage's *It's a Wonderful Life, A Radio Show.* She would like to thank the cast & crew for their dedication, the Production team for their hard work, director Colin for his patience and her fiancé Nick for his support.

Georgia Ciaputa (Ragg/Betty Dullfeet/Defense) - After a thirty-year hiatus from acting, Georgia is thrilled to be a part of this production at NFCT! Her past experiences include: The Shakespeare Program at The London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art, The Williamstown Theatre Festival, where she toured with The Second Company and The Provincetown Playhouse, where she was cast as Amy Greene in Strawhead and had the opportunity to work with playwright Norman Mailer. A Note from the Director ...

As a young writer who came of age during Germany's defeat in the First World War, Brecht was acutely aware of the economic implications in the collapse of the once mighty German Empire. Grand aristocracy ended and was replaced by a precarious peace. The old Monarchists now had to jockey for power with Conservatives, Liberals, Social Democrats, Nationalists, Populists, Socialists, and Communists. Economic stability was tenuous and was only achieved for business owners with the appointment of Adolf Hitler as Chancellor in 1933.

Writing in exile in Scandinavia in 1941, Bertolt Brecht wanted to expand his antifascist body of work. He had already written a revue of scenes of life in the police state (Fear and Misery in the Third Reich), but he hadn't yet tackled the man himself who embodied the evil that forced him from his homeland. Drawing inspiration from the gangster dime novels he loved so much, Brecht decided to meld this style with his own critical view of the Third Reich. Arturo Ui was just as much born out of a hatred for Hitler as it was Brecht's critical view of Capitalism.

In her seminal treatise The Origins of Totalitarianism, Hannah Arendt describes its foundations in Imperialism: "Imperialism was born when the ruling class in capitalist production came up against national limitations to its economic expansion. The bourgeoisie turned to politics out of economic necessity; for if it did not want to give up the capitalist system whose inherent law is constant economic growth, it had to impose this law upon its home governments and to proclaim expansion to be an ultimate political goal of foreign policy." The grocers and executives of the Cauliflower Trust in this play not only set in motion the inciting action of bribery and political kickbacks, but also start the work on the annexation of their economic and civic neighbors.




