PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Thank you for coming to see the North Fork Community Theatre here at the Jamesport Meeting House. And thank you to the Jamesport Meeting House for allowing us to use their beautiful space. Today's show, *Santaland Diaries* will be performed by Colin Palmer. Colin has performed on the NFCT stage many times, including as a member of our Youth on Stage program. The reason we are performing at an 'off-site' venue is because we are renovating the North Fork Community Theatre. Our theater's "Home Sweet Home" is a converted 1800's church at 12700 Old Sound Avenue in Mattituck that we have performed in since 1962. We started the renovations in August, and hope to be able to open back up this spring. The improvements will include adding an orchestra pit, a rehearsal room, a storage room, and theatrical technology including new lighting and rigging infrastructure. So far, we have raised over \$845,000 out of the \$950,000 needed for the project.
