




What does one think of when the court of Henry VIII is the subject? Opulence, bloody executions, religious upheaval?

Hilary Mantel, who has entirely convinced me that she spent a previous life as a fly on the wall of Hampton Court, manages to include all of those things in *Wolf Hall* but her genius is in shining a spotlight on the true revolution at Henry's court: the rise of the self-made man.

A judge's son, Thomas More, becomes Chancellor. A butcher's son, Thomas Wolsey, becomes Cardinal. A knight's daughter, Anne Boleyn, becomes Queen. And Thomas Cromwell, the publican's son, a mysterious mercenary and auto-didact, becomes the right hand of the King.

As we all know, and these four learned - the only step after reaching the apex of power at this court was straight down.
