It may seem silly to think of women fantasizing about ways to take out their boss, but the reasons behind the silliness are very real. We have a single mother, a married woman being objectified by her boss and a divorcee trying to take back her life. All three feel undervalued and disrespected. All wonder if they can make it.

I'm so glad you're here to take this ride into the past with us, but don't let our 1970's decor and costumes fool you into thinking these themes are just part of our history. People supporting people in the face of adversity is a constant theme that outlines our past and gives us hope for the future. It's the reason I feel so strongly about the YOS program. We support each other simply because we have a common interest in theatre... and that is a beautiful thing.
