

Mattituck artist Kathy Pasca has a lifelong love and practice in visual arts including watercolor and photography. She discovered paint pouring Fall of 2021.

Paint pouring is fluid art using water and other mediums to thin acrylic paint, moving them on canvas or wood using various techniques to create unique effects. Favorite techniques include dutch pour, swipe and split cup.

She loves using iridescent and metallic colors in her work. (shine your phone's flashlight on them to get the full effect!)

Inspired by the natural world and the organic nature of this art form, her works tend to fall into the categories of the elements - water, earth, fire, air, and ether, and are unified by artistic elements such as color, shape and texture.
