





# It takes a community...

### Director's Note:

Hello! My name is Nicholas Auletti, the director of *One Christmas Eve At Evergreen Mall*. Thank you all for coming to this festive selection for the season. When I first proposed this play, I thought this was the perfect romantic-comedy stylings of a Hallmark movie, yet without the cookie-cutter clichés, we are all used to. I'm not saying there's anything wrong either, but *One Christmas Eve At Evergreen Mall* has been a joy to work with, as has the cast and the crew.

The mall is a commercial theatre in the sense that it is a communal space where people try on different costumes and outfits, pay for expensive props and accessories, and want to be seen, it can become a date night, and it has all the characters you'd ever need to write a holiday show.

This play, One Christmas Eve at Evergreen Mall, has every aspect of the things mentioned above and rips away the masque of Christmas as not just a holiday but as an idea. At Christmastime, we pretend that everything is ok. The family gets together and acts like no one had a divorce, a kid hasn't been naughty at school, hormones aren't a thing in teenagers, and grandpa doesn't have an alcohol problem. This show brings to light what lies beneath the Christmas spirit and confronts it with humor, kindness, logic, and empathy. No more are the niceties pasted on people's faces as they pass by, but a genuine emotion starts to form as we talk to these characters in the mall. These characters have problems, and the joy of Christmas is the backdrop for solving their love lives, low-economic income, and poor communication skills. Showing everyone needs honesty towards the holidays doesn't sugar-coat how our daily lives are bombarded with a falsified version of Christmas joy.

There's a My Morning Jacket song (featured in the show) called "Xmas Time Is Here Again (Bring Out the Joy). I hope this play brings joy and that we all feel it as we leave the theatre and bring joy outside in the real world this holiday season. Stay Frosty!
