



COUNTING THE BALLOTS

This year in keeping with the fact that we will be going to the polls for school board elections and presidential primaries and presidential elections, the NFCT took a poll last show of its patrons in the hope of receiving some ideas as to what sort of shows our audience wanted to see and to help the Play Reading Committee with their very delicate task of selecting the plays for next year. The plays that were summarized in the last program were as follows: "Carnival", "Diary of Anne Frank", "Dr. Cook's Garden", "Child's Play, Ghosts", "See How They Run", "Spoon River Anthology", and "Stop The World I Want To Get Off". This presented a wide variety of choices. The audience that responded, and it was a pretty fair turn out so to speak, preferred musicals and comedy to drama. That is not unusual. Highest number of votes went to the comedy "See How They Run", which was followed by the more dramatic "Spoon River Anthology" and finally by "Stop The World I Want To Get Off". Not a bad year's program if it were to be adopted by the membership when they meet to make the decision after the recommendations of the Play Reading Committee. The musical "Carnival" was very close behind, as was "The Diary of Anne Frank". The other three shows were also rans.

The suggestion list was very interesting and gives us an idea of what we should look into for the future. Plays such as "Romeo and Juliet". "Story Theatre", "Three Penny Opera" and "Cabaret" were all suggested while the musicals "Fiddler on the Roof", "West Side Story", "Brigadoon", and "Fantasticks" all got several votes.







YOUTH ON STAGE

The Summer of 1971 marked a new event on the North Fork. One of our NFCT long-time members, Maureen Cahill, came up with the idea of a summer theatre production for the teen-age community. Under her tutelage and direction some 90 young people came together to put on Meredith Willson's "Music Man". The kids, calling themselves "Youth on Stage" began rehearsals with Mrs. Cahill and for the next seven weeks (five nights a week) sang, danced, built and painted sets, made costumes, learned stage make-up, and sold tickets. For them the not-so-long hot summer turned out to be a time of fulfillment and self-discovery. The production played to packed houses here in our theatre for six nights with resounding success. Reviewers called the show "lyrical, professional, a truly-together production" and "fast-moving, colorful, enthusiastic."

Maureen is now planning a show for the coming summer. She will direct the memorable Rogers and Hammerstein musical play "South Pacific", again using only teen-agers for the cast and crew. Pat Tucker who appears as "Susy" in "Wait Until Dark" will assist Maureen as musical director.

The show will be presented in mid-August and "Youth on Stage" hopes you'll be there for an enchanted evening at "South Pacific".
